Pick your type of fundraiser, fundraising period, and goal amount.



Share your fundraising story. Inspire your friends, family, and co-workers to support the cause through your fundraising story. The better they connect with your story, the more likely they will donate. Be sure to not just tell them what the cause is, but why the cause is important to you.

Can the Wilder Institute/Calgary Zoo help me with my fundraiser?

We can provide technical support for your fundraising page, as well as support materials such as info graphs, etc. We cannot promote your campaign or share any donor information or reimburse any expenses for your fundraiser.

Where do the funds raised go? Can I donate to my favourite animal?

You can direct your funds to any of our featured campaigns such as the Area of Greatest Need, Wildlife Conservation, or Animal Wellbeing. We greatly appreciate support to our cherished animals and ask that you direct your funds to the Wilder Institute/Calgary Zoo's Animal Wellbeing fund and join your zoo in providing dynamic habitats and engaging enrichment activities for the animals that live at the Wilder Institute/Calgary Zoo.

How will the information collected through my fundraiser be used?

The information collected will be used for issuing tax receipts, recognition, Wilder Institute/Calgary Zoo updates and opportunities to further support wildlife conservation.

Can I get a special experience with an animal if we raise a lot of money?

While we greatly appreciate any funds you raise, we are not able to offer special animal experiences.

What kind of materials can I access?

Will my donors and I receive a tax receipt for the amount raised?

If you would like all participants or donors to receive a tax receipt, please ensure to collect complete information (full name, address, email address, and donation amount) for tax receipts. We cannot issue ereceipts.
